Policy: 414 ELECTRONIC DEVICES POLICY

I. Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to define the World Learner School's position on appropriate student usage of cell phones, MP3 players, tablets and other electronic devices.

II. General Statement of Policy:

The school accepts that technology is pervasive and that many students bring electronic devices to school for both entertainment and safety.

Nevertheless, electronic devices can be a distraction in a learning environment and the school needs to set limits on electronic device usage.

- The World Learner School recommends that students do not bring any electronic devices to school.
- Electronic devices that are brought to school will be powered off during normal school hours (including break times) and stored out of sight.
- Electronic devices can only be used during normal school hours with the permission and under the direct supervision of the student's classroom teacher.
- Students are forbidden to use electronic devices in rest rooms.

Failure to comply with the school policies regarding use of electronic devices will result in the electronic device being confiscated for the day. Repeated violations of the policy will result in a complete ban on the student's use of personal electronic devices on school premises.
