

## Classroom Supply List for Ashley's LE

**These are items that might be shared. Please do NOT label them unless indicated:**

- 1 school bag\* *please see note below*
- 1 change of clothes in a **small**, clear ziplock bag (labeled and fits in the locker)
- 1 pair of indoor shoes with non-skid soles
- 3 sturdy pocket folders (NO CLASPS please; Please label clearly in the upper right hand corner with name and label one take home, one unfinished work & one extra w/o your child's name on it)
- 1 spiral bond notebook
- 1 white, **1 inch**, three ring binder for organizing finished work
- 1 quadrille notebook (I know they are sold at Office Depot & online)
- 2 dozen #2 Ticonderoga pencils (Their lead is harder than most and they last *much* longer!)
- 1 box of color pencils (24 pack recommended)
- 1 large eraser ("Magic Rub" brand is recommended)
- a box of Kleenex

**Second year students:** a pkg. of construction paper with multiple colors, 1 ream of white printer paper, 1 pkg of expo markers, 2 **small** sketch books, scotch tape, 2 dish soap

**Third year students:** a pkg of child-sized scissors, 1 white liquid glue bottle, clear sandwich bags, 1 **small** sketch book, 2 pack of glue sticks, 1 pack of loose writing paper

The following items are optional:

- Knitting needles (thick wood or plastic are nice)
- Crochet hook

Donations of the following items are always needed and greatly appreciated!

- Yarn
- Science supplies (vinegar, salt, food coloring, molasses, vegetable oil, sugar, baking soda)
- Guinea Pig food and bedding (or a gift card to Petco and your child can do a going out to pick up the supplies)
- Clay
- Used magazines (especially ones with animals)
- Card stock
- Scrap-booking paper
- Vegetable seeds (for biology experiments)
- Pencil sharpeners

\*School bag: your child needs a backpack or a bag to carry things back and forth to school each day. We want the children to be able to walk up and down the stairs safely and independently with their belongings. During the winter they will have winter gear, which they may or may not be carrying back and forth, depending upon your preference. Please keep these things in mind when helping your child choose a bag for school.

Please **do not** send extra notebooks, journals, mechanical pencils, markers, fancy sharpeners or other things to school that are not on the list. Most of the time, those things are distractions among the students. If these extra items are appealing to your child, your child could set up a “homework basket” at home with these fun pencils, sharpeners, notebooks, etc. Thank you for your cooperation with this.
